Confirmation Service Hours

Confirmation involves a deeper commitment to the work of Christ and during your Confirmation preparation; it is the time to become more involved in the life of the Church by sharing your gifts and talents.

As a Confirmation candidate, you are required to give 26 hours of service in the following categories: liturgical, parish and community. This will enable you to more fully understand the needs of your parish and your community. It will also provide you with various opportunities to witness your faith to others.

<u>Liturgical Ministries</u> (12 Hours)





Altar server: Senior altar servers are ministers assisting the pastor during Mass.

Usher: The student usher assists the regular ushers in whatever capacity is needed.

Reader: The reader proclaims the Word of God during Mass. Please note that the readings should be studied the week before you are to read.

Parish Hours (8 Hours)





Parish service hours include anything that is done to improve or assist our cluster parishes.
